#### HISTORY OF ONE HUNDREDTH INFANTRY.

The 100th Regiment of Illinois Volvnteer Infantry, also known as the Will County Regiment, was recruited in July and August, 1862, and rendezvoused at Camp Irwin, Joliet, in the latter month. Frederick A. Bartleson, major of the 20th Illinois Infantry, who had lost an arm at Shiloh, was commissioned Colonel of the 100th, and the Regiment was mustered into the military service of the United States on the 30th of August, 1862. Of the total enrollment of 921 officers and enlisted men, all but 73 were enlisted in and credited to Will county.

September 2, 1862, the Regiment was ordered to the front and moved via the Chicago & Alton railroad to Springfield, Ill., and thence to Louisville, Ky. The men were unarmed and undisciplined, and as ignorant of military tactics as a Digger Indian is of the dead languages, but they soon learned the duties of a soldier in the school of experience and hard service. The Regiment never became a pastmaster in the art of military evolutions, as laid down by Hardee and Casey, but for nearly three years it was on the firing line in every battle and skirmish in which the Army of the Cumberland was engaged.

Arriving at Louisville, the 10th was assigned to the 1st Brigade, 2d Division of what was then known as the Army of Kentucky, composed exclusively of new troops. This assignment was only temporary and on the 1st of October, after the arrival of General Don Carlos Buell and his army, the Regiment was transferred to the 15th Brigade, 6th Division, Army of the Ohio. General Milo S. Haskell commanded the brigade and General Thomas J. Wood the division.

The first experience of the Regiment under fire was near Bardstown, Ky., where it was ordered by General Haskell to make a charge. Moving promptly forward the Regiment drove the enemy through the town and two miles beyond. It was not engaged at Perryville, but took part in the subsequent pursuit of General Bragg, as far as Wild Cat, Ky., where the pursuit was discontinued, and from thence marched by way of Columbia and Scottsville, Ky., and Gallatin, Tenn., to Nashville, where it arrived November 26, 1862.

Meanwhile General Buell had been superceded by General William S. Rosecrans and the army was now known as the Army of the Cumberland, and so remained until the troops of which it was composed were mustered out of service after the war had ended. In the movement upon Murfreesboro, the 100th was engaged in skirmishes at Lavergne and Stuart's Creek, and participated in the battle of Stone River on December 31, 1862, and January 1, 2 and 3, 1863. On the first day of this battle the right wing of the army, commanded by Major General A. McD. McCook, was broken and driven back upon the center. The 100th, with other troops, was ordered into action, gallantly charged the enemy, drove them back and assisted in holding the positions occupied by the center and left wings until General Rosecrans could establish a new line for his shattered right.

After the battle of Stone River, the army, which had heretofore formed but one army corps, was reorganized, the right and left wings of three divisions each, forming the 20th and 21st army corps respectively, while the center, of four divisions, retained the old corps number, the 14th. The respective commanders of these corps were Major Generals George H. Thomas, Alexander McDowell McCook and Thomas L. Crittenden. There was also reserve corps of three divisions commanded by Major General Gordon Granger. The 100th was one of the four regiments of the 1st Brigade, 1st Division, 21st Army Corps, the other regiments being the 58th Indiana, 26th Ohio and 13th Michigan. The brigade was commanded by Colonel George P. Buell and the division by General Thomas J. Wood.

In the advance from Murfreesboro to Tullahoma and Chattanooga, the 100th marched to Manchester, Tenn., crossed the Cumberland mountains into the Sequatchie valley, from whence it moved to Shellmound, where it crossed the Tennesee river and entered Chattanooga September 9, 1863, almost on the heels of the retreating Confederate rear guard.

The next day the Regiment moved out to Chickamauga creek, taking position at Lee & Gordon's mill. It took part in the movements preliminary to the battle of Chickamauga, in which it was hotly engaged on Saturday, September 19. Sunday forenoon, in obedience to orders from Colonel Bartleson, the Regiment charged forward across the Brotherton field, passed the Brotherton house and up to and across Lafayette road, unmasking the enemy's batteries and developing his line of battle. Being unsupported, the Regiment was repulsed with a severe loss in killed, wounded and prisoners. Colonel Bartleson being among the latter. For many years it was contended that no Union troops crossed the Lafayette road on the second day of the battle, but the writer has in his possession a letter, dated November 21, 1891, from Captain S. C. Kellogg, of the 5th United States cavalry, at that time secretary of the Chickamanga and Chatanooga National Military Park Commission, in which he acknowledges that the 100th did make a charge as is herein stated, and cross the Lafayette road on Sunday, September 20, 1863. The total loss of the Regiment in this great battle was 50½ per cent of the 339 officers and men engaged.

Soon after the battle of Chickamauga the command of the Army of the Cumberland devolved upon General Thomas, who relieved General Rosecrans. The army had been again reorganized, the 20th and 21st army corps being discontinued and the troops were all merged into the 4th and 14th army corps. The 10th now belonged to the 2nd brigade, commanded by Brigadier General George D. Wagner, 2nd division, 4th army corps. Major General Phillip H. Sheridan commanded the division and Major General Gordon Granger the corps. At the battle of Missionary Ridge, November 25, 1863, the Regiment was on the left of the division in the front line and charged almost directly in front of Bragg's head-quarters, carried the enemy's works at the foot of the ridge and then pushed for a crest capturing many prisoners and a battery and pursuing the routed Confederates as far as the Chickamauga river, where the pursuit ended, owing to the lateness of the hour, the dark, ness of the night and the further fact that the enemy had succeeded in getting safely across the stream.

The next day the 10th started on the long march for Knoxville to the relief of General Burnside. Upon the approach of the relieving column General Longstreet raised the siege and retreated toward Virginia. The 100th was a part of the force that made the Dandridge campaign, a short but severe one and barren of results. The Regiment wintered in East Tennessee, being stationed at Athens for about six weeks, from which place it marched in the spring to Cleveland. Tenn., to prepare for the opening of the Atlanta campaign.

This campaign opened May 4,1864, and for the next four months there was almost constant fighting. The skirmishing was incessant and the battles frequent. Of the latter may be mentioned Rocky Face Ridge, Resaca, Adairsville, Dallas, Kenesaw Mountain, Peachtree Creek, Atlanta and Jonesboro, as among those in which the 100th participated.

Returning northward by rail, while General Hood with his army, after recrossing the Chattahoochee river, marched in the same direction, the Regiment for some time paroled the railroad in either direction as far as Stevenson, Ala, and Dalton.Ga. When Sherman cut loose from his communications and started on the "march for the sea," the 4th corps was left behind, which fortunate circumstance gave the Regiment the opportunity to take part in the battles of Spring Hill, Franklin and Nashville, the most complete and decisive victory for the Union arms of the civil war, and to which the 100th contributed its share by the active part it took in the capture of Montgomery Hill and the lines of hipeastworks so shubbornly defended by the gallant soldiers of the army it had confronted for nearly three years.

In this computation no man is counted twice. Some of the dead were wounded in action that occurred previous to the one in which they were killed, while many were wounded twice and some three times.

The statement of the loss sustained by the Regiment is compiled from personal knowledge and data in possession of the writer, and is believed to be absolutely correct, and is accepted as being so by survivors of the Regiment to whom it has been submitted. The reports in this respect are incomplete.

Twenty-four officers of the 302 enlisted men were mustered out of service June 12, 1865, at Nashville, Tenn., but all these were not present with the Regiment. Its actual service covered a period of about thirty-three months, every day of it at the front.
