The Alton Battallon, composed of the companies of Captain John Curtis and Simon J. Stookey, was mustered into the United States service at Camp Butler June 21, 1864. The strength of the companies was 91 and 90 respectively. Departed for the field June 25, 1864. Mustered out at Camp Butler October 7, 1864.
